



EFFECTIVE MAY 11/21 BEACH FIRE REGULATIONS

Changes to District of Tofino Outdoor Burning Bylaw No. 1071, 2008

A dramatic increase in the numbers of beach fires has led to an increase in harmful smoke, garbage, burning of TOXIC driftwood and unattended fires. Beach fire regulations have changed effective May 11, 2021 and fines have increased for beach fire infractions. Please contact the District of Tofino Bylaw department for specific questions.

What You Need To Know About the New Regulations

No person shall start, maintain, or gather around or near any fire at any beach that is not contained within a portable fire pit that is raised off the ground and contains ventilation for hotter, cleaner burning.

*Burning Of DRIFTWOOD of ANY size is strictly prohibited

*Beach Fires at Cox Beach and Tonquin Beach strictly Prohibited

*Beach Fires are permitted between 8am and 10pm only
